CHARUSAT has established Manikaka Topawala Institute of Nursing (Formerly known as Charotar Institute of Nursing) with B.Sc. nursing in the year 2009 with the student intake of 40. In the year 2012, student intake was enhanced to 60. In the year 2011, the Institute launched a new program, General Nursing and Midwifery, with a student intake of 40. In 2014, the PG program was launched in 5 specialties (Medical surgical nursing, Child health nursing, Mental Health nursing, Obstetrics and gynecology nursing and Community health nursing) with intake of 4 seats in each specialties. We have added Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with 20 seats annual intake in the year 2023. To foster the research work, the Institute established Ph.D. program in 2011. The institute has been set up with the primary aim of meeting the requirements of nurses at various hospitals and institutes of the state, nation, and worldwide.
