EDW 1. INTRODUCTION

Charotar University of Science and Technology is an unaided University established under Gujarat Private Universities Act 2009. It has a lineage of more than 115 years of social service. UNIVERSITY POLICY IN ESTABLISHING ENDOWED CHAIRS

Endowment Chair: Meaning, Purpose and Funding

2.1. Meaning & Initiation:

The Endowment Chair is an endowment fund created by CHARUSAT. The interest accrued from the fund shall be used in carrying out academic enriching activities and to promote research and innovation as delineated further in this document.

It shall be a constant endeavour of CHARUSAT and its constituents to establish more and more endowment Chairs. The Board of Management (BOM) is authorized the formation of Chair for its constituents. The reporting authorities as defined in EDW 3 shall be reporting the activities to the BOM on periodical basis.

2.2. Purpose: The Endowment Chair is established with the purpose of promoting excellence in Department/ Institute/ Faculty. This may be:

- 2.2.1. Inviting distinguished professors of National and International repute
- 2.2.2. Promoting research and innovation
- 2.2.3. Organizing seminar/workshop/other such activities.
- 2.2.4. Extension activities for benefits of society.
- 2.2.5. Any other activity which may be approved by the Provost.

2.3. Funding:

- 2.3.1. When started endowed chair, any donor (individual/ corporate/ organization) who come forward and donate Rs. 25 Lakhs (Chair Endowment Fund) shall have an endowment chair established at CHARUSAT. The Department/ Institute/ Faculty and the name shall be as mutually decided by the donor and CHARUSAT.
- 2.3.2. Later on CHARUSAT shall have revised funding policy.
- 2.3.3. In case no donor is available, CHARUSAT may create Endowment Chairs from its own fund.
- 2.3.4. Only the interest accrued from the Chair Endowment Fund shall be used for furtherance of Chair activities. However, based on requirement of specific activities CHARUSAT may allocate matching amount equal to the interest.
- 2.3.5. Unless there is an explicit MOU with Donor, the interest shall be used for activities as described in Clause EDW 2.

EDW 2. ADMINISTRATION OF ENDOWED CHAIRS

Every Department/ Institute/ Faculty shall appoint a Senior Teacher for Co-ordinator of Chair activities. He/ She shall get an honorarium as decided by CHARUSAT from time-to-time. He/ She shall be generating requisite reports of the Chair activities.
