

CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT PROCESS – BACHELOR OF PHYSIOTHERAPY

Steps undertaken in the process of curriculum development:

- 1. Curricula from various states, national and international institutions are studied for benchmarking.
- 2. A comprehensive literature review is undertaken to study research & new developments resulting in a detailed curriculum of the Physiotherapy courses, which includes competency and skills-based models followed nationally as well as internationally.
- 3. Feedbacks are sought from various stakeholders who are students, alumni, teachers, parents, industrial experts etc. The feedbacks on curriculum are obtained annually. Stake holders are consulted and their feedbacks are procured at the designing and implementation stage of the curriculum.
- 4. Feedback responses are analyzed and summarized which if dictates the need to revise the courses thereby the information and revised courses are presented to the member of Board of studies and academic council for their suggestion and hereto approval of the new or revised courses.
