Comments:

1- There are still some grammatical errors such as:

Abstract- "based narrow-band bandpass filter" should be changed into "based on narrow bandpass filter"

2- The references are not in their order and some of them are missing (e. g. [14], [18]).

3- Caption of Table II must be changed from "able 2 Obtained simulation results in bandpass filter" into "Table 2 Obtained simulation results in bandpass filter"

4- Caption of Table III should be changed from "Table 3 Performance comparisons between this works and previously published filters" into "Table 3 Comparison of Performance between this work and the previous ones"
