### A. Introduction

The task of managing Disaster Risks and Disaster Events is heavily dependent on Scientific and Engineering/Technological knowledge and evidence-based technique. The application of Science and Technology can substantially reduce losses of lives and property, as is illustrated by the following examples –

- China, flooding in 1931 and 1959 caused millions of fatalities, but now with early warning and evacuation systems, as part of risk reduction policies, such great loss of life no longer occurs.
- In Bangladesh, a national flood warning system provides warnings up to 10 days ahead to millions of villages, helping them defend against the regular flooding and preserve household assets.
- In The Netherlands, a long-term program title "Room for the River" is undertaking dozens of infrastructure projects to mitigate the likely impact of Climate Change and to support development that reduces flood risks and negative environmental impacts.

This training is concerned with how disaster risk and losses can be reduced through the greater use of Science and Technology - including the natural and the applied field such as environment, health, agriculture, water and engineering. It reviews the importance of Science and Technology in SFDRR, the world's blueprint for action to reduced disaster risk end it examine the opportunities and barriers to make adoption of Science and Technology. It makes proposal for how to promote in exploring Science, Engineering, Technology and Innovations for Disaster Risk Reduction.

The conceptual basis for DRR has undergone significant change, partly as a result of scientific and technological study. the common view of disasters is simply hazards or events is now challenged by the view that disaster risk is the outcome of both natural and human influenced factors, with risk expressed in terms of potential losses of lives, assets or income. This is shaping new approaches to use of Science and Technological approaches in DRR, Resilience Building and Climate Change Adaptation. Also, greater attention is being given to other sources of Disaster Risks, beyond natural hazards alone.

With a thrust on socially relevant Research and Development, CHARUSAT strives to transform the society through creation, augmentation, dissemination and perpetuation of knowledge for capacity building for DRM. In this regard, the MoU was signed between GIDM and CHARUSAT on dated 29<sup>th</sup> Oct' 2018 at GIDM to initiate various capacity building activities through partnership. It was discussed and decided to have a strategic positioning of DRR in capacity building programs of academicians, researchers and students across the state. As decided in the meeting, GIDM, in collaboration with CHARUSAT, will explore possibilities of creating a cadre of Master Trainers who can drive on exploring the use of Science and Technological dimensions in DRR.

As part of the follow-up, GIDM, in association with CHARUSAT, has organized Tier II for Faculty Members of CHARUSAT on **Exploring Science, Engineering, Technology and Innovations in Disaster Risk Management** from 28-29<sup>th</sup> Nov' 2019 at GIDM.

The social sciences have also played a central role in developing new thinking on Risk, Vulnerability and Poverty, the risk process and human roles in the accumulation of risk. The social science also provide core knowledge on Risk Perception, Individual Risk-related behavior and Decision-making processes.

### **B.** Purpose

The expected outcome of this ToT is to explore the use of Science, Engineering, Technology and Innovations for DRM by following the implementation guidelines of the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction pertaining to the State. The use of Science and Technology for DRM will define the expected outcomes of the innovative science and technological dimensions and work under each of the four Sendai Framework priority areas of actions and the ways to monitor progress and needs.

*Key Words*: Risk Informed Planning, Capacity Development, Climate Change, Early Warning, Information Management, Risk Identification & Assessment, Governance, Disaster Risk Management, Science and Technology.

### C. Objectives

Role of Science and Technology for Disaster Risk Management (DRM) has constantly evolved globally in accordance with different international declarations from the IDNDR (International Decade of Natural Disaster Reduction) to the Hyogo Framework for Action (HFA: 2005-2015) and the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction (SFDRR: 2015-2030). SFDRR highlighted the important role of science and technology for disaster risk reduction in each of its priority areas, as well as emphasized the essential presence of science and technology to a wide range of stakeholder engagements.

The aim of this ToT is to identify existing knowledge and skills in the State with regard to disaster mitigation, preparedness, response and recovery so that a long term capacity development plan may be developed keeping Science and Technological aspects in context. Under this, the following specific objectives has been pursued -

- Assess and update the current state of data, scientific and local and indigenous knowledge and technical expertise availability on disaster risks reduction and fill the gaps with new knowledge
- Identification (*scoping*) of Role of Science and Technology in SFDRR
- Support a stronger involvement and use of Science and Technology in policy- and decision-making within and across all sectors at all levels
- Identify the needs of policy- and decision-makers at all levels for scientific data and information to strengthen preparedness, response and to "Build Back Better" in Recovery, Rehabilitation and Reconstruction to reduce losses and impact on the most vulnerable communities and locations
- Analyze the ethics of scientific and technological inputs before, during and after disasters and address the ethical challenges in accessing science and technology for everyone

### **D. Duration and Venue**

This two-day program is divided into two section. The first section will include the Basics of Disaster Risk Management and various associated Terminologies used in DM filed; International, National and State frameworks for DRR. The second section of the training will cover the theme "Use of Science and Technology for Disaster Risk Management (DRM)" considering the existing strength of the state level.

### E. Certificate

As the programme is for two days, the participants are expected to be regular in attendance and to observe punctuality. On successful completion of the programme, each participant will be awarded with a *Certificate of Completion* recognized by GIDM and CHARUSAT, jointly.

Selected Participants-Faculty Members from CHARUSAT (Master Trainers) will be recognized and empaneled as Resource Person(s) in GIDM to join various capacity building activities of GIDM.

### F. Prerequisites

- University degree or equivalent
- Background in engineering, environmental sciences, architecture, geography, anthropology, international relations or any curriculum sharing a global perspective. This list is not exhaustive. We encourage people of all disciplines and backgrounds to join.
- Motivation, persistence, and interest in learning about disaster risk reduction
