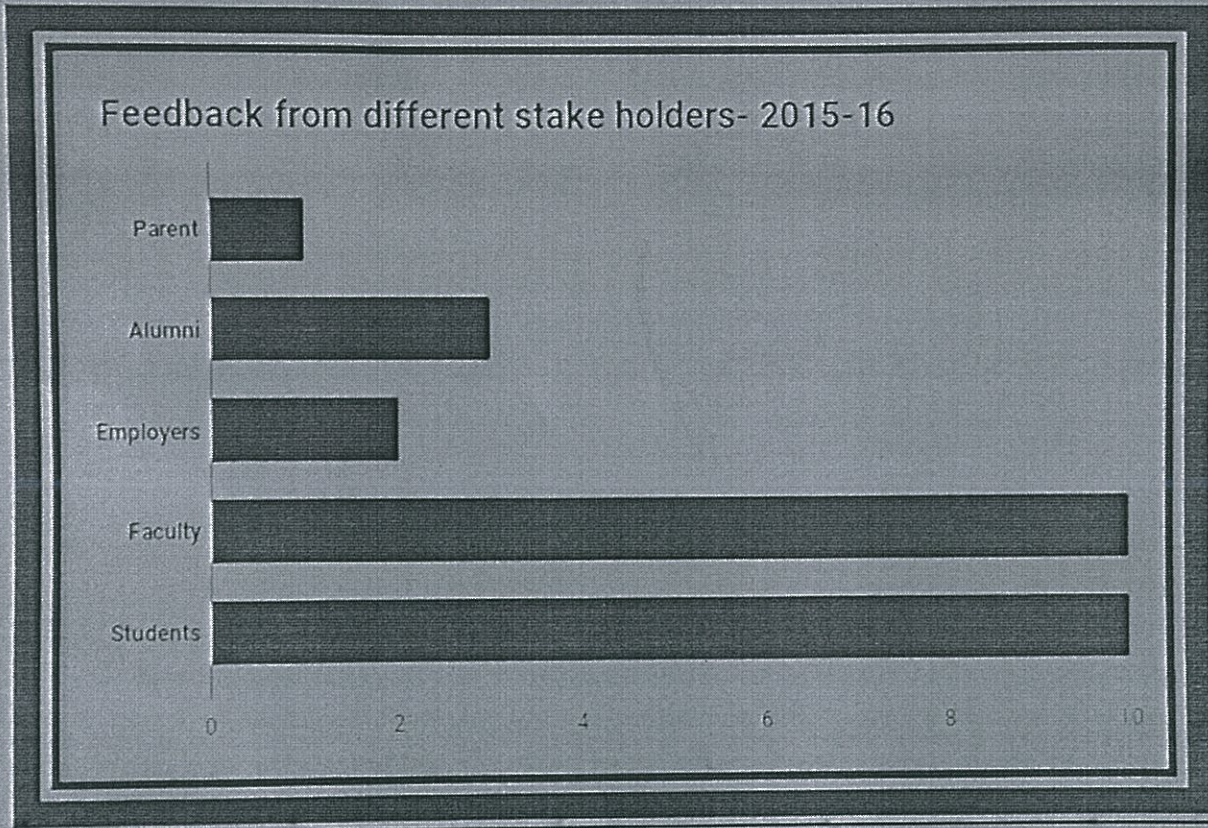





Summary of feedback on curriculum

- **Action taken:** As per the suggestion from Academic peers and Faculties non-communicable disease and oncology topics were included in the BPT syllabus. (Annexure 1)

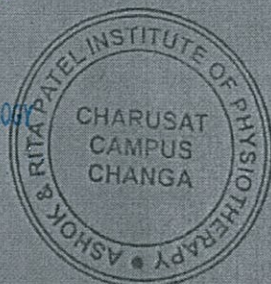

Proceeding 06.16.03:

- Dr. Balaganapathy has presented the revised list of examiners to the members which have been received from about 20 colleges across Gujarat.
- Dr. Neeta Vyas has given asked about inclusion of list of examiners who are out of state and to consider them as panel of examiners.
- Dr. Balaganapathy has said that the university does not have the policy for the external examiners to be called from out of state in BPT and MPT programs and could be done in PhD Programs.

Item 06.16.04:

- **For Information & Discussion:** To discuss the detailed syllabus of BPT 3rd year (5th & 6th semester) for the academic year (2016-17).

Proceeding 06.16.04:

- Dr. Dhruv has explained the procedure of distributing each course among two faculties and various references have been taken for the formulation of content of each course. The syllabus of not only Indian universities but across the globe has been referred. The inputs have been taken from the alumni to modify the content of courses and to avoid repetition of topics under various course headings.
- Dr. Nilima Patel has asked to change the nomenclature of courses like Exercisetherapy I & II as "Human Movement Science I & II".
- Dr. Neeta Vyas has suggested adding "wholistic approach" in the course.
- Dr. Annamalai has asked to have few topics like oncology, non-communicable diseases as content of final year BPT syllabus.
- Dr. Balaganapathy has reassured that while redesigning the syllabus, the change in the terminology will be considered and other areas for Final year BPT syllabus.

Resolution 06.16.05:

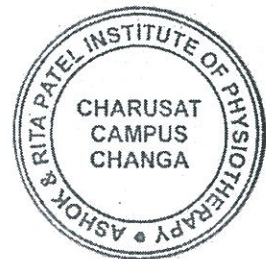
- The Board members have approved the introduction of OSCE pattern for Clinical training course at BPT and MPT level.
